## Instructions

Young readers are invited to participate in this exciting new program. It's easy! For every age-appropriate book you read (or have someone read to you), you decorate a "BRICC" with your name and a drawing on it and submit it for display on the wall of the library. In 12 weeks, see if you can read 10 books and build a whole house out of BRICC's. Prizes will be awarded for each BRICC, with a larger prize for each completed house.

Build your house one BRICC at a time and help us lay a foundation for reading in Culver City!

Eligibility: Children middle school and younger

**How to Get Started:** Pick up an entry form at the library or on our web site at **www.ccfol.org** and fill in all your information. Select an age-appropriate book to read. (The librarians will be happy to help you choose one.) Start reading!

**Rules:** Complete a BRICC form for each book you read (or have read to you) and turn it in at the library. Every time you turn in a completed BRICC form and a BRICC you designed, we will add a BRICC to your house on the wall of the library. It takes 10 BRICC's to complete your house. Everyone who participates will be invited to a party on July 15, 2006 to celebrate, so mark your calendar! Every participant who builds a complete house by June 27, 2006, will receive a special prize.

**Dates:** From April 4, 2006 to June 27, 2006. Prizes for individual BRICC's will be awarded on the 1st Tuesday of the month at a 7:00 p.m. storytime, during the final celebration on July 15, 2006 and at other various times as announced.
