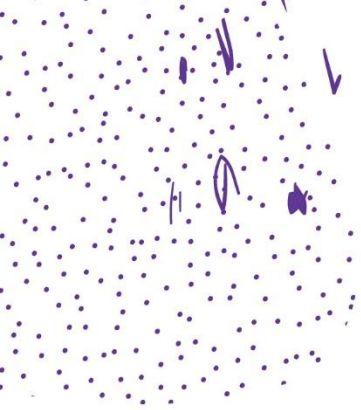

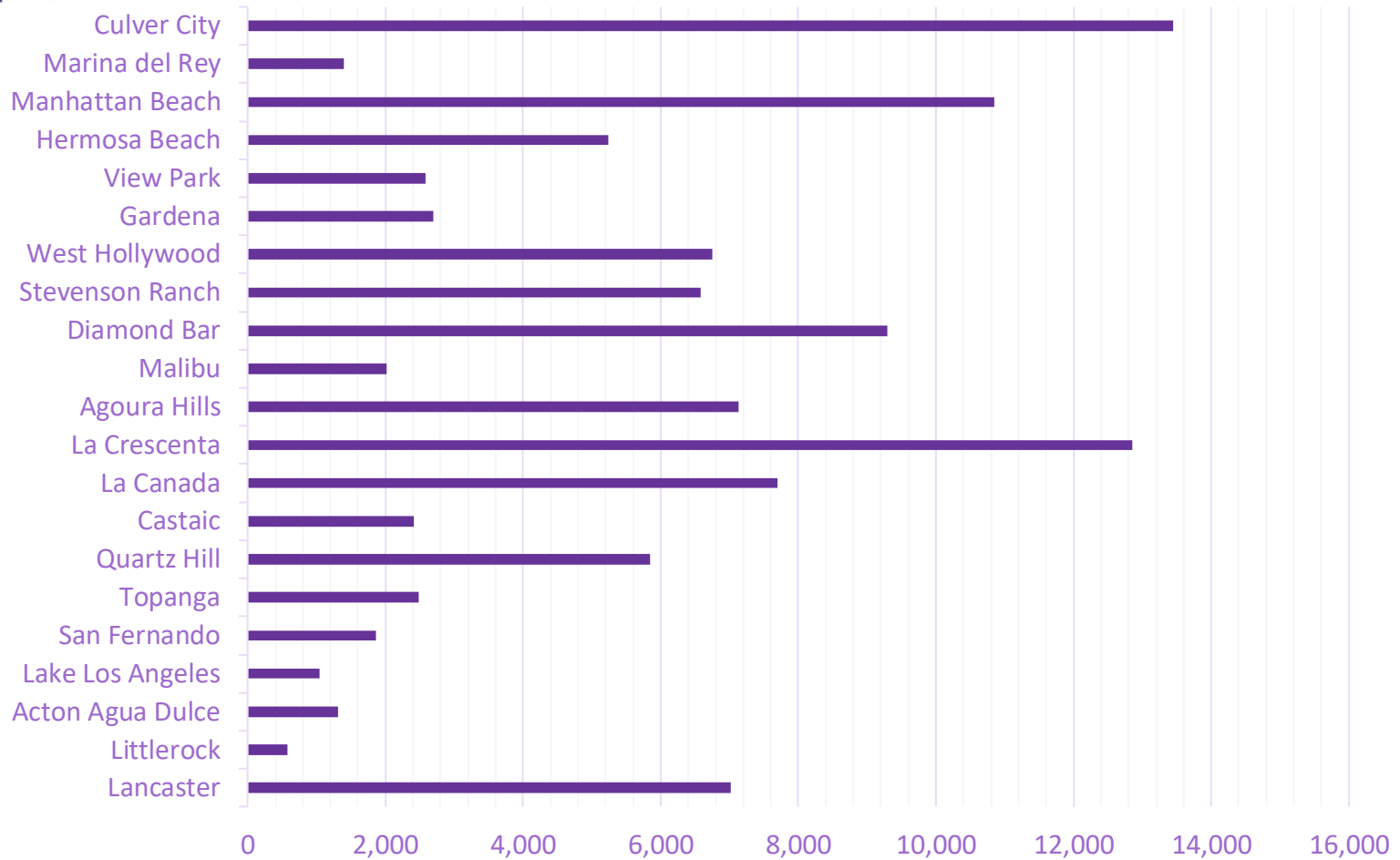

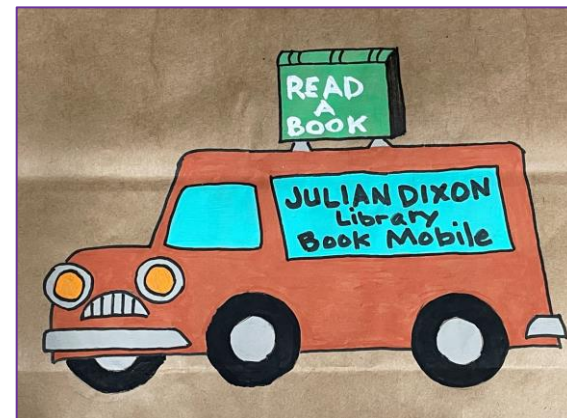
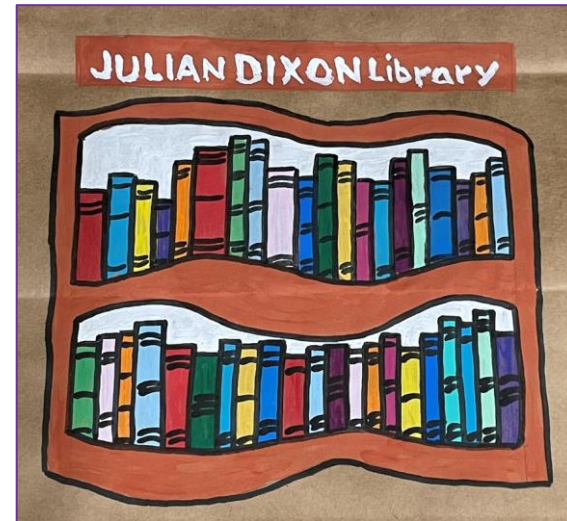


Snapshot across LA County Library

Circulation during Sidewalk Service: Feb 2021



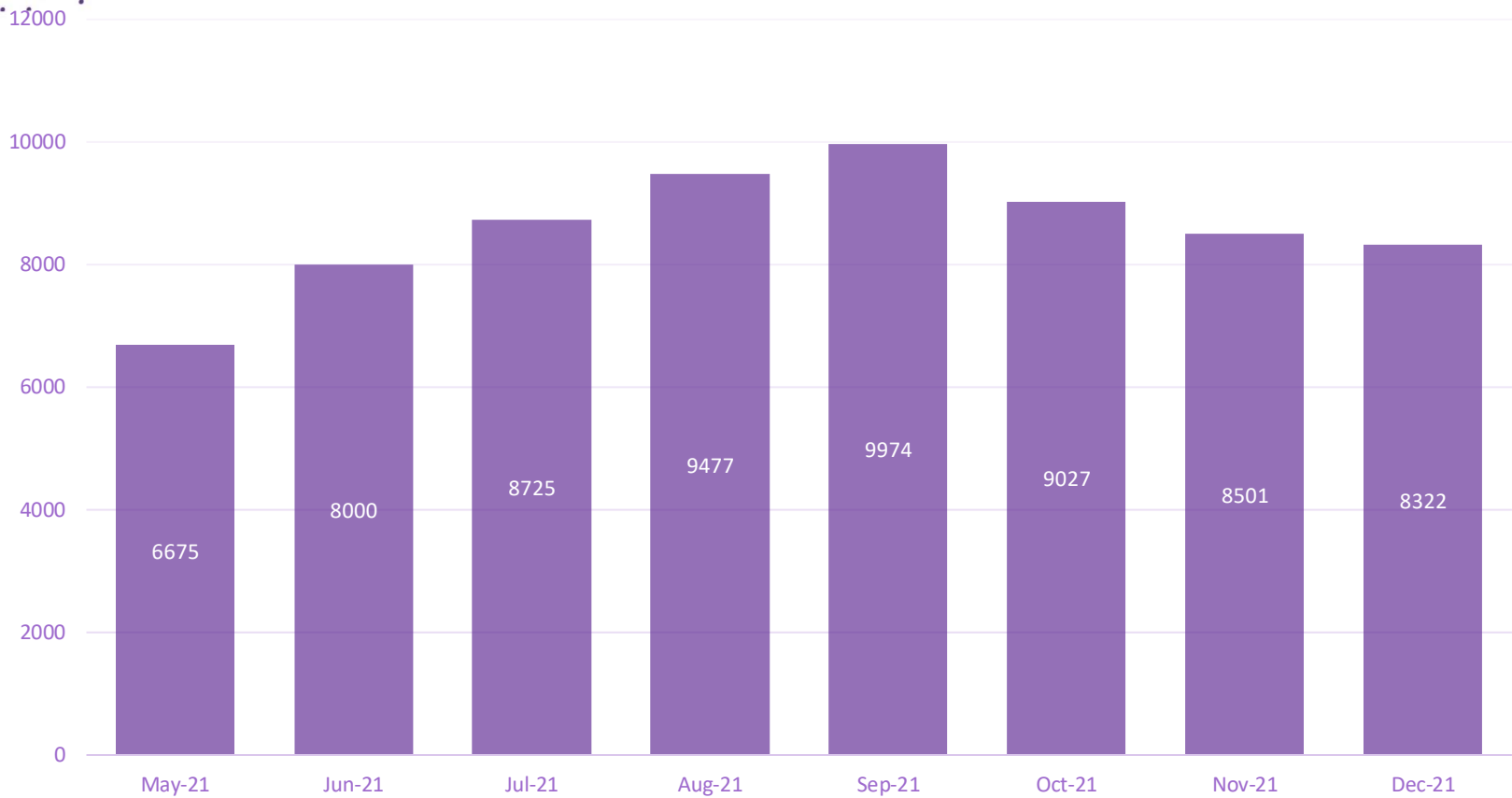

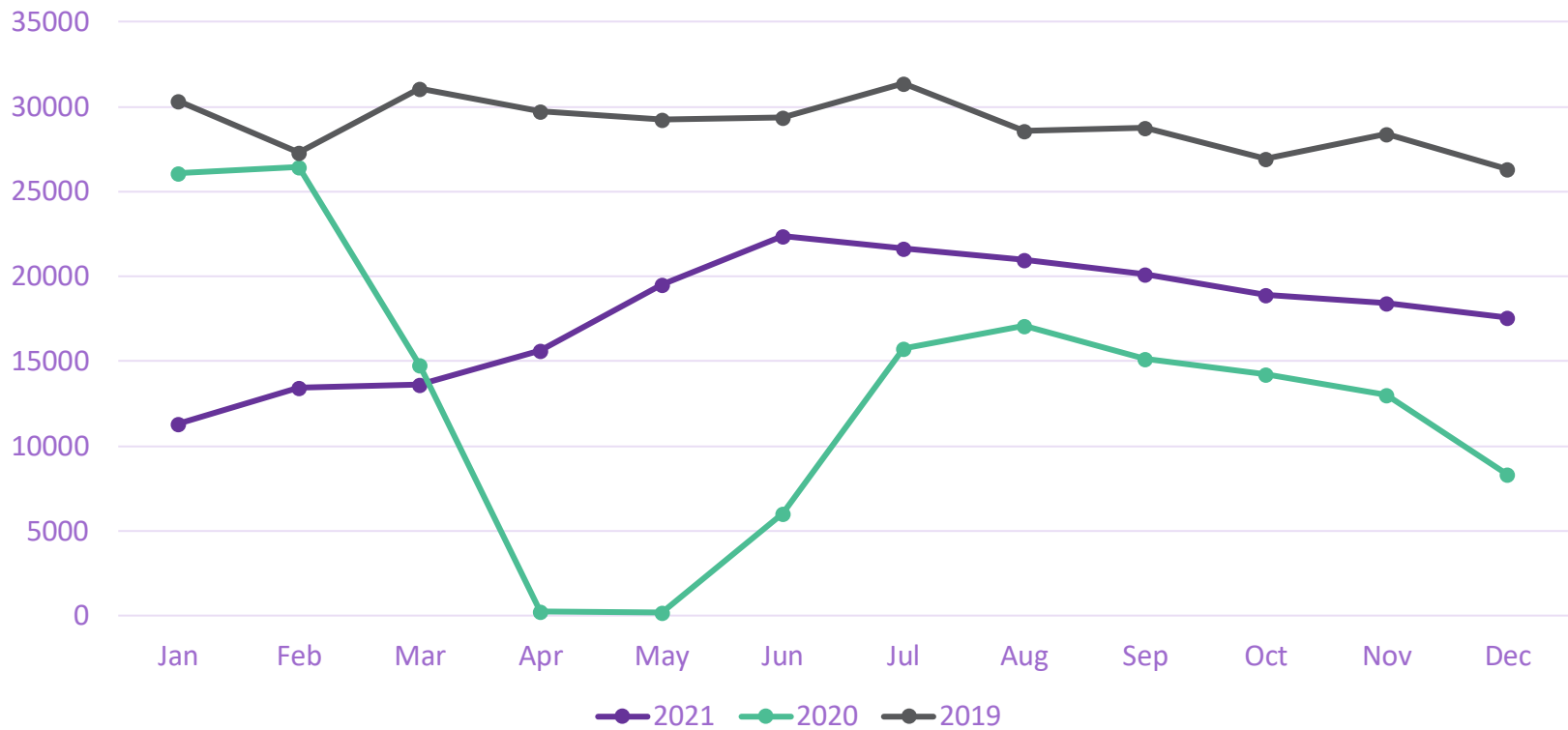


Gate Count 2021

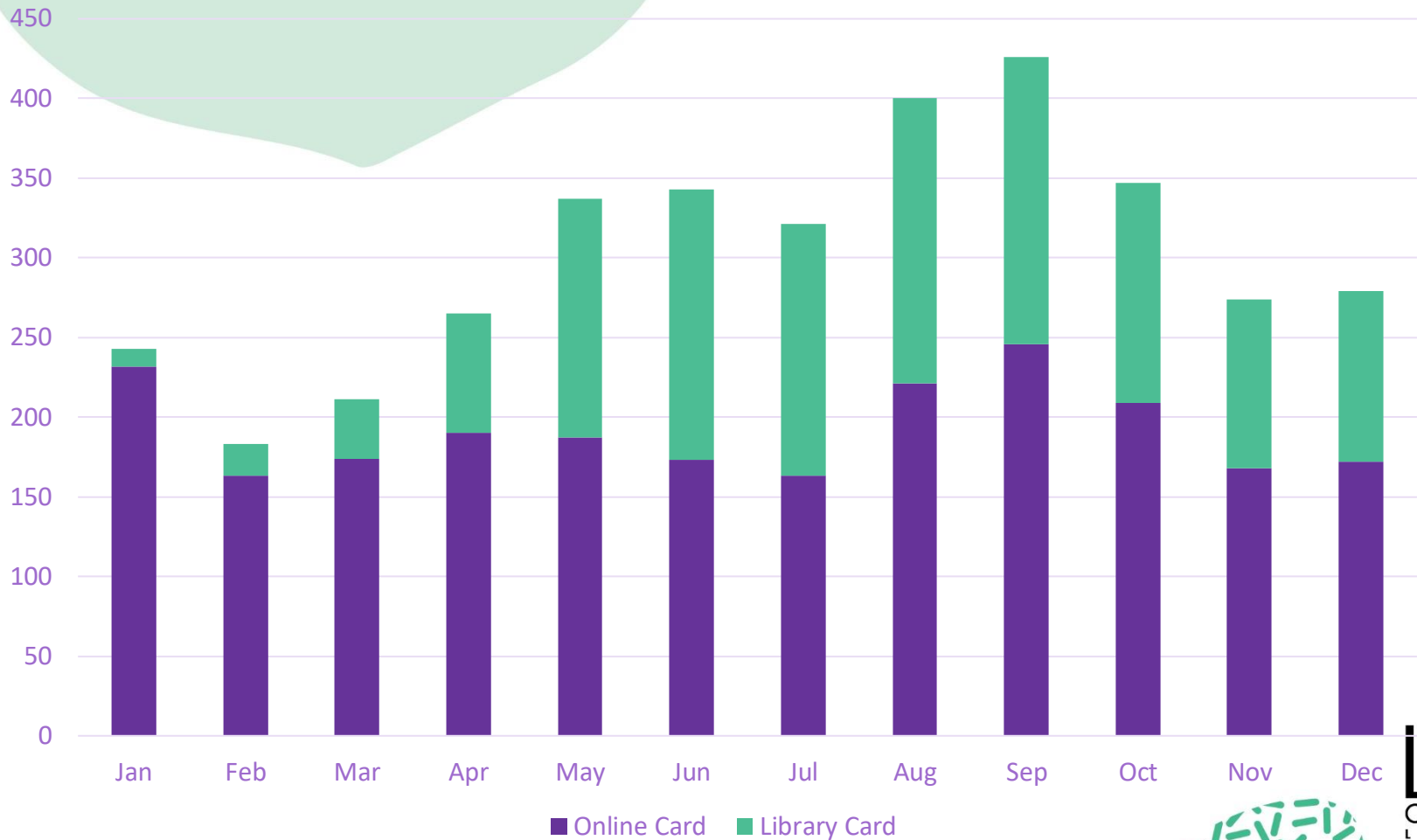

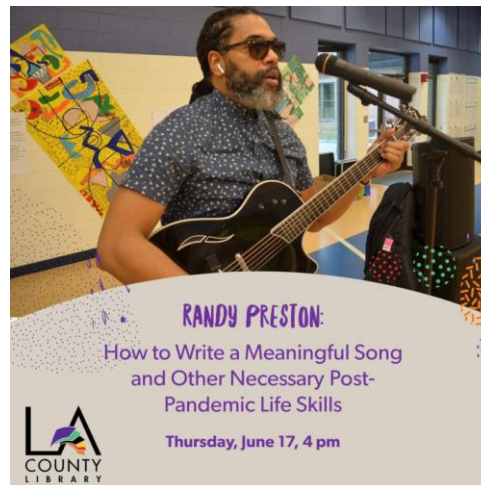
With the Student Card Plus, your child has access to the Library's resources and many tools to support their schoolwork, including:

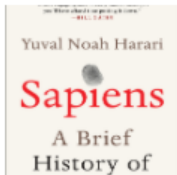
